Born Nov. 23, 1880, at Sauk Centre, Minn; d. Apr. 17, 1906, at Newberg, Oregon; m. June 7, 1899, by Rev. Stacey Smith, at Sauk Centre, to Samuel A. Dimond. She was a member of the Methodist Episcopical (sic) Church, a true Christian in every sence and an energetic and faithful worker in the church and its various branches, being organist and librarian and Secretary of the Sunday School, at different times, and held every office there was in the Epworth League, during her membership while at Sauk Centre, Minn. Upon leaving there and moving to Oregon, she transferred her membership to the M.E. Church at Newberg, Oregon, where she still retained her membership when she died. She obtained her education in the Public Schools of Sauk Centre, and was in her Freshman year in the High School when she was married to Mr. Dimond. she was a loving, affectionate and dutiful wife, and obedient daughter to her parents. Loved music, and loved to have a good enjoyable time, such as a picnic sociable or party. A daughter of Duane and Mary (Van Norman) (Torrey) Philes, and only child of Duane Philes to reach maturity. But she had one half sister Ella E. (Torrey) Dimond, who died Feb. 2, 1926, in Portland, Oregon, and who was the wife of F. N. Dimond, an uncle of her husband. Her mother and father, Mr. & Mrs. Duane Philes, left Minnesota and came to Oregon soon after the death of Mrs. Dimond, and located in Portland, so as to be near Mrs. Philes' daughter Ella, and their grand-daughters Iris and Harriett, daughters of Samuel and Harriett Dimond. Mr. & Mrs. Frederick N. Dimond and Mr. & Mrs. Duane Philes, died and are buried in beautiful Rose City Cemetary, in Portland. Mrs. Harriett Maude Dimond, at her death left two daughters, one being but twenty one days of age and the other but three years, who have since grown to woman-hood and are still living, being the only direct descendants of Duane Philes.
